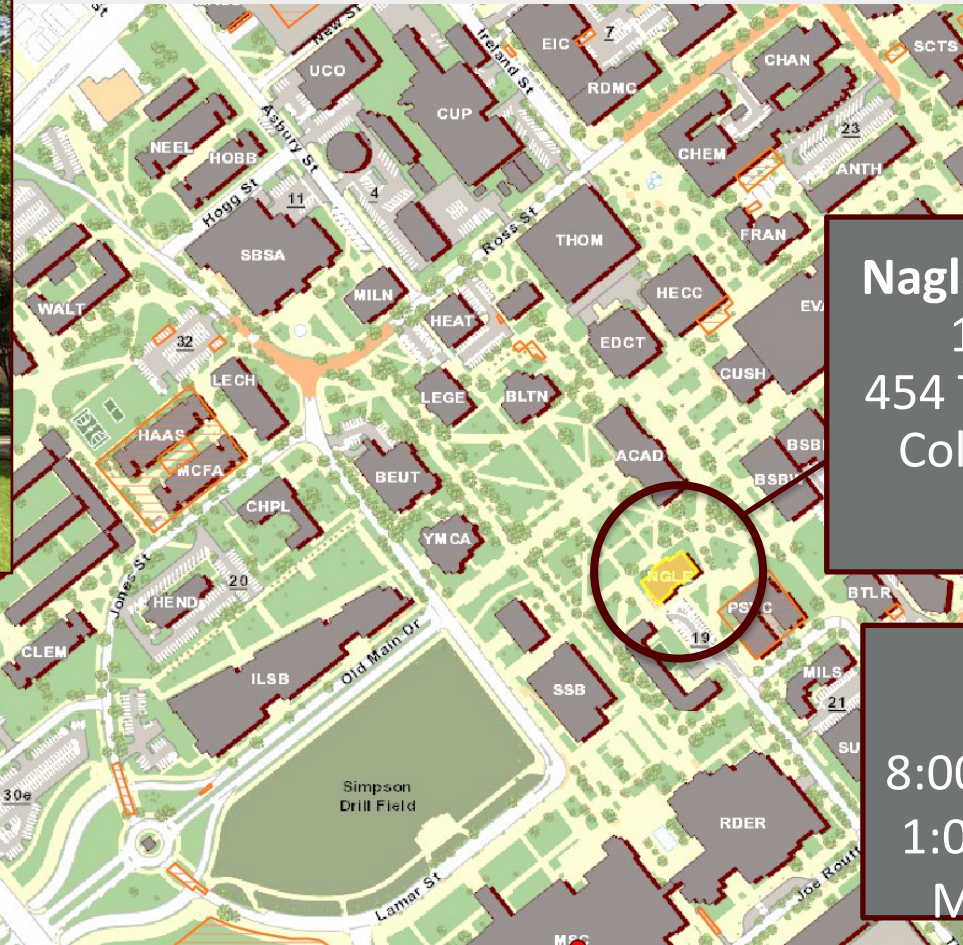
Fall 2022 graduate and professional student enrollment: 16,588 -- about 22% of total enrollment

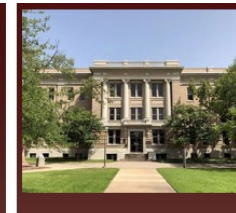
