

Submittal Requirements Checklist for Doctoral Students

Once you have <u>scheduled your final examination</u> (oral defense), complete the following steps to clear for graduation.

Steps to Complete PRIOR to Submission

- Use <u>Thesis Office templates</u> or the <u>LaTeX document template</u> to format your manuscript
 - New to Overleaf or LaTeX? Check out this <u>Learn LaTeX in 30 Minutes</u> crash course, or watch a recording of the TAMU <u>Overleaf beginner's workshop</u> webinar
- View the virtual <u>document preparation conference</u>.
- Refer to our <u>Thesis</u>, <u>Dissertation</u>, and <u>Record of Study Guidelines</u> for requirements, deadlines, and formatting.
- Successfully complete your <u>final examination</u>. Your department will submit the report of final exam results to The Graduate School.
- Complete all committee-requested corrections and content changes to your document before submitting it.

Steps to Complete by the Submission Deadline

- Submit the Written Dissertation Approval Form
- Upload the dissertation as a single PDF file to <u>Vireo</u>.

Steps to Complete for Graduation Clearance from Thesis and Dissertation Services

- Complete all dissertation corrections requested by your reviewer.
- Apply for graduation in Howdy.
- Register for the semester (unless cleared by early deadline to avoid registration).
- Pay the \$170 processing fee through <u>Howdy</u>: your account will be charged no more than four weeks after you have submitted your manuscript.
- Submit the <u>Copyright and Availability form</u>. This form must be submitted and signed by the student and committee chair.
- Complete <u>doctoral surveys</u>.
- Get <u>permission to use copyrighted material</u> if necessary and review third-party previously published material using <u>Fair Use guidelines</u>.
